Life Change by the Numbers

In 2017, **62** guests were served.

67% facing mental health challenges

65% overcoming addictions

20% with disabilities

15% from corrections backgrounds

15% experienced domestic violence

7 ANEW Leaf Graduates completed our 5 month transitional housing program, were placed in long-term housing, and are receiving two years of after-care case management.

So far in 2018, **36** guests served:



7 receiving ANEW Life after-care case management



5 participating in ANEW Leaf transitional housing program



24 entered ANEW Step case management



17 are actively employed
8 began new jobs after being unemployed



7 reached 3 months of sobriety
7 reached 1 year of sobriety




5 moved into long-term housing



Financial Snapshot


2017 Total Revenue: \$388,967

As ANEW Place continues growing and expanding our services in 2018, we’re preparing to double our capacity in the future by adding a dedicated ANEW Leaf transitional housing facility. Additional support allows us to move two part-time staff into full-time and add a full-time case manager.

What does ANEW Place provide?

Personalized case management for each guest which involves employment coaching, developing a resume, and preparing for the interview. Our Case Management team commits to visit our guest on site once a month while providing an open line of communication with the employer to create the optimal environment for success.

What does your business provide?

Entry level job opportunities for ANEW Place guests seeking to reenter the workforce. Working in tandem with ANEW's team to provide job coaching, encouragement, and accountability to help our guest chart a path forward towards independent living.
